AUDITION COMPONENTS

Perform Sections A, B, C and D explained below. Speak the name of each section and count off clearly.



TECHNICAL (SCALES AND CHORDS)

- 1. Please perform any four different major scales of your choice, other than C Major. Two octaves ascending and descending, both hands, in 8th notes (Suggested tempo range: 70-100 BPM), with proper fingering.
- 2. Please play the following triads in all positions (root position, 1st inversion, second inversion):
 - F major
 - Ab major
 - B major
 - E minor
 - Bb minor



PREPARED PIECE

Please perform a piece that you think best displays your strengths. It may be any genre, e.g. classical, pop, jazz, blues, R&B, etc. Original music composed by the applicant is welcome.



IMPROVISATION

Please perform a Blues improvisation based on a standard 12-bar blues progression in G (chord chart and <u>backing track</u> provided).
