CHOOSE YOUR PROGRAM

Complete the application form found online and then send with the nonrefundable processing fee in Canadian dollars.

SEND YOUR OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS Send scanned copies of notarized official transcripts and other required documents.

RECEIVE A LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Once tuition deposit is paid and all conditions for the program acceptance have been met, you will receive an official letter of acceptance.

OBTAIN A STUDY PERMIT AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Most applicants will need a valid study permit, so please allow adequate time for processing. Visit the Government of Canada's IRCC website:
